

## Problem-Solution Chain Answer Key

### Problem Chain Chart

1. Problem: The poster blew away, and no one would know where to go.  
Solution: Teacher made a new sign and hung it at the entrance.
2. Problem: The microphone broke, so people couldn't hear the announcements.  
Solution: Students borrowed the music teacher's portable speaker.
3. Problem: The prize table collapsed, scattering toys and candy.  
Solution: Parents set up a stronger table and reorganized the prizes.

### Extension (Sample Answer):

Solving each problem kept the fair running smoothly. If the poster, microphone, or table hadn't been fixed, the event would have failed. Step-by-step solutions show how teamwork and problem-solving prevent small problems from becoming bigger ones.

### Teacher Notes:

- Emphasize that each **problem caused a new challenge**, forming a chain.
- Have students draw arrows between problems and solutions to visualize the "chain."
- For enrichment: Ask students to add an **imaginary next problem** and create a solution for it.
