Problem-Solution Matches

- $1 \rightarrow D$ (Too dark \rightarrow Add lamps or blinds)
- $2 \rightarrow E$ (Plants wilting \rightarrow Water them regularly)
- $3 \rightarrow B$ (Forgot lunch \rightarrow Borrow/share food)
- $4 \rightarrow G$ (Books scattered \rightarrow Shelve and organize them)
- $5 \rightarrow F$ (Messy desks \rightarrow Clean with soapy water)
- $6 \rightarrow A$ (Losing score \rightarrow Use a scoreboard)
- $7 \rightarrow H$ (Hot slide \rightarrow Shade or wait until later)
- $8 \rightarrow C$ (Group arguing \rightarrow Vote to decide fairly)

Teacher Notes

- This activity helps students practice recognizing cause-and-effect style
 thinking in a problem-solution format.
- Encourage students to explain their reasoning out loud; this deepens comprehension.
- For the extension, allow creative answers (e.g., "The classroom could move closer to the windows" for Problem 1).
- Differentiation tip: Struggling students may first underline clue words like dark, wilting, forgot, or mess to signal the kind of solution needed.
