Teacher's Guide

- **Skill Focus:** Connecting Progressive Era legislation to the social, economic, and political problems of the time.
- **Differentiation Tips:**
 - Provide a short vocabulary list for terms like regulation, corruption, and consumer protection.
 - Allow students who need support to complete the first row together as a model.
- **Engagement Strategies:**
 - Create a "Reform Relay" where groups race to match laws and issues before checking with teacher.
 - Invite students to vote on the reform they believe made the biggest difference and explain why.
- **Extension Ideas:**
 - Students research a modern law that protects consumers or the environment and compare it to a Progressive Era reform.
