**Quick Reflection:** A strong reflection should identify who benefited and what specific problem was improved.

### Teacher's Guide

- **Skill Focus:** Distinguishing between political, economic, and social reforms of the Progressive Era; analyzing reform impacts.
- **Differentiation Tips:**
  - Provide a word bank for students struggling with terms: *political* = *government*, *economic* = *money/business*, *social* = *living conditions/people*.
  - Allow partner sorting for students needing additional support; challenge advanced learners to add two new examples for each category.
- **Engagement Strategies:**
  - Create three corners in the room labeled *Political*, *Economic*, and *Social*; students move to match their answers physically after discussion.
  - Encourage brief debates if students disagree on category placement, using historical evidence.
- **Extension Ideas:**
  - Have students research a current reform issue and decide which category it belongs to.
  - Invite students to make a mini-poster illustrating one reform goal and its real-life impact.
