How to Write Like a Journalist
In this activity, you'll learn to coach an AI to write like a real journalist -clear, factual, and objective. Each step helps you add one layer of your Prompt Sandwich , so the AI knows what kind of reporting you want. By the end, you'll have a polished "reporting prompt" that produces balanced, trustworthy summaries.
Step 1 - Choose the Role - Tell the Al what kind of journalist it is. Different journalism roles lead to different writing styles.
Examples: A political correspondent reporting for a national newspaper. A loca news reporter covering community issues. A fact-checker for an educational magazine. A science journalist explaining new discoveries

Step 2 - Define the Task - What do you want the AI to do? Report? Verify? Summarize? Explain? The more specific the task, the more accurate the response.
Examples: Summarize a breaking news story about renewable energy. Verify a viral claim about ocean pollution. Explain how social media affects voting behavior.

Step 3 - Add Context - Who is this report or fact-check for? Are readers students, the general public, or professionals? Context changes the tone and level of detail.
Examples: For high school students learning about environmental issues. For a general audience interested in science news. For readers who want a simple fact-check summary.

Step 4 - Set Constraints - Good journalism follows rules: accuracy, clarity, and
