Broken Prompt #1 - "Explain stuff about space." Fixes:

1. *"Explain how stars are formed in space, step by step."*
 - Narrowed focus to one process, requests clear structure.
2. *"Summarize the main differences between planets, stars, and galaxies in simple terms for a middle schooler."*
 - Adds comparison + audience guidance.
3. *"Write a one-paragraph explanation of black holes, including what they are and how they affect nearby objects."*
 - Specific topic + length + details.

Broken Prompt #2 - "Tell me about history." Fixes:

1. *"Explain the causes and effects of the American Civil War in three short paragraphs."*
 - Topic + structure.
2. *"Give a timeline of the most important inventions of the 20th century, with brief notes on their impact."*
 - Format + narrowed scope.
3. *"Write a short speech as if you are Martin Luther King Jr. explaining why nonviolent protest matters."*
 - Creative twist + historical accuracy.

Broken Prompt #3 - "Write something about animals." Fixes:

1. *"Compare the hunting strategies of lions and wolves, focusing on teamwork."*
 - Comparison + focus on behavior.
2. *"Write a fun fact sheet about penguins for elementary school kids."*
 - Audience + format.
3. *"Explain how animals adapt to survive in deserts, giving at least three examples."*
 - Specific environment + requirement.

Broken Prompt #4 - "Give me advice." Fixes:

1. *"Give me five practical study tips to prepare for a big test."*
 - Scope + number.
2. *"Write friendly advice for someone nervous about their first day at a new school."*
 - Tone + scenario.
3. *"Provide step-by-step advice for saving money on a small weekly budget."*
 - Specific goal + structured answer.
