Agreement Fixers Answer Key

The soccer team carried **its** uniforms into the locker room, and each of the players hung up **his** jersey. Everyone **was** excited for the big game, and neither of the captains wanted to forget **his** speech. The committee of parents announced **its** decision to provide snacks, and every child promised to bring **his or her** own drink. Somebody left **his or her** water bottle behind, and the twins said **they** would return for it later. One of the coaches parked **his** car near the field, but Maria and Sofia walked back to **their** house together.

Teacher Notes

- **Collective nouns** like *team* or *committee* are usually singular when the group acts as one unit (*its decision*).
- **Indefinite pronouns** like *everyone*, *somebody*, *each*, *neither*, *one* are singular, so they need singular pronouns (e.g., *his*, *her*, *its*).
- Watch for **number mismatches**: *Everyone were excited* → *Everyone was excited*.
- For **compound antecedents** joined by *and* (Maria and Sofia), the pronoun must be plural (*their*).
- A good editing strategy: **circle the antecedent first**, then check if the pronoun matches in **number (singular/plural)** and **gender/neutrality**.
