The Antecedent Flip Answer Key

Teacher Notes

- This activity highlights how **pronouns must shift** when antecedents change in **number (singular/plural)** or **form (individual/collective)**.
- Watch out for **indefinite pronouns** (*each, neither, one, somebody*) - they are singular even if they sound plural.
- A helpful strategy: **circle the antecedent first**, then double-check the pronoun's match.
- Extension idea: Have students **swap antecedents of their own creation** with a partner for added practice.
