### Teacher's Guide

- **Differentiation Tips:**
  - For younger students (Grades 3-4), read the proverbs aloud and discuss what they might mean before matching.
  - For advanced students, challenge them to use each proverb in an original sentence or short story.
  - Allow students to illustrate one proverb's meaning as a visual interpretation.
- **Engagement Ideas:**
  - Create a "Proverb of the Week" wall where students bring examples from books or shows that reflect that saying.
  - Encourage group discussions about which proverbs connect to real-life experiences.
- **Extension Activities:**
  - Ask students to find proverbs from other cultures and explain how they teach similar life lessons.
