Teacher's Guide

- **Differentiation Tips:**
 - Review unfamiliar vocabulary like *leopard*, *silver lining*, or *determination* before beginning.
 - Offer clues or context sentences for struggling readers to make connections between proverbs and modern meanings.
 - Challenge advanced students to paraphrase the modern meanings in their own words.
- **Engagement Ideas:**
 - Let students "translate" famous proverbs into how they might sound on social media today (e.g., "#NoUseCryingOverSpilledMilk").
 - Play a matching game where students hold cards with either proverbs or modern meanings and find their "partner."
- **Extension Activities:**
 - Encourage students to research how certain proverbs originated and why their lessons still matter today.
 - Have learners write mini-dialogues using both the old and modern versions to show understanding.
 - Assign creative writing tasks where students must include at least two proverbs in a story or comic strip.
