Since students generate their own questions, here are **sample accurate** responses:

Right There Example:

Q: Who discovered penicillin?

A: Alexander Fleming.

Think and Search Example:

Q: Why was penicillin important during World War II?

A: It treated infected wounds and saved soldiers' lives.

Author and Me Example:

Q: How might penicillin have changed families' lives during the 20th century?

A: Families likely lost fewer loved ones to infections, which improved health and life expectancy.

On My Own Example:

Q: Have you or someone you know ever taken antibiotics? How did it help?

A: Answers will vary—students draw on personal experience.

Teacher Notes:

- Purpose: This serves as a quick check of students' ability to distinguish all four QAR types.
- Assessment Tip: Check for correct labeling of QAR type more than exact wording.
- Classroom Use: Collect these as students leave class to informally assess understanding and guide the next lesson.
