Cycling Through QAR Answer Key

Q1: Right There - The passage states they were called “velocipedes.”

Q2: Think and Search - You must connect multiple details (crowded streets, cheaper than owning horses, practical for city travel).

Q3: Author and Me - Requires mixing prior knowledge of modern bikes with the historical description.

Q4: On My Own - Based on the student's personal experience.

Q5: Right There - The passage directly mentions rubber tires and pedals.

Q6: Right There - It states bicycles gave women greater independence to move freely.

Q7: Author and Me - Connects author's statement about fashion with student's understanding of broader social change.

Teacher Notes:

- **Guided Practice:** Model how to identify a “Right There” question first, then have students try others in pairs.
- **Extension:** Challenge students to write one new question of each QAR type about the passage.
- **Assessment Tip:** Check not only the labeling but also the reasoning students give; ask them *why* they chose that type.
