R-Vowel Strips Answer Key

Answers will vary. Sentences must:

- Use at least one card from the set.
- Be complete sentences with correct capitalization and punctuation.

Examples:

1. I planted flowers in the garden.
2. The storm shook the windows.
3. The teacher found a feather on the desk.
4. The bird made a swirl in the sky.
5. The turtle made a slow turn toward the water.

Teacher's Guide

- Review the meaning of each word card to ensure students understand vocabulary before writing.
- Encourage students to **underline** the r-controlled word they used in each sentence to reinforce the phonics focus.
- Provide scaffolds such as sentence starters for students who struggle with generating ideas.
- For an extension, have students combine two or more r-controlled vowel patterns in one longer sentence or write a mini paragraph using multiple cards.
