1. **iftar** - the meal eaten at sunset to end the daily fast
2. **suhoor** - the early morning meal before fasting begins for the day
3. **zakat** - giving charity to help those in need; one of the Five Pillars of Islam
4. **crescent** - a curved shape like a thin slice of the moon
5. **mosque** - a place where Muslims gather for worship

(Any correct student sentence demonstrating accurate meaning should be accepted.)

Teacher's Guide

Differentiation

- Need support: Provide a short word bank of simplified definitions to match first.
- Ready for a challenge: Have students add an adjective or descriptive phrase to enhance each sentence (e.g., "crowded mosque," "thin crescent moon").
- Cultural learning: Allow students to research or share additional Ramadan vocabulary.

Engagement Ideas

- Invite students to illustrate one term and label their drawing with a sentence they wrote.
- Use a "word gallery walk" where students display their best sentence on a sticky note to share with the class.

Extension

- Create a short paragraph using all five words in a meaningful way.
- Compare these terms to traditions or symbols from another holiday students know.
