Student responses will vary. Look for:

- A clear claim that understanding Ramadan promotes respect and unity
- At least **one** supporting reason (e.g., encourages empathy, reduces stereotypes, builds friendships, celebrates diversity)
- Specific details or examples to strengthen the argument
- Strong persuasive tone and complete paragraph structure
- Age-appropriate conventions (sentences, punctuation, transitions)

Example acceptable ideas:

- Learning about Ramadan helps people understand the importance of kindness and charity.
- When we listen to others' traditions, we show respect and reduce misunderstandings.
- Shared knowledge builds bridges between cultures.

Teacher's Guide

Instruction Tips

- Review structure of a persuasive paragraph: *claim* → *reasons* → *examples* → *closing sentence*.
- Model how to use transition words (e.g., *first*, *also*, *for example*, *in conclusion*).
- Discuss key vocabulary like **traditions**, **unity**, **diversity**, **empathy**.

Differentiation

- Support: Provide a graphic organizer or sentence starters (e.g., "One reason we should learn about Ramadan is...").
- Challenge: Turn the paragraph into a short persuasive speech or include a call-to-action.
- ELL Support: Allow brainstorming of ideas with peers before writing; give visuals of Ramadan traditions.
