Pillars Insight Hunt

The five pillars of Islam provide a foundation for Muslims' spiritual life, guiding how they relate to God and to their community. The first pillar is the declaration of faith, affirming belief in one God and the Prophet Muhammad. The second pillar is prayer, which many Muslims perform five times a day as a way to stay connected to God. The third pillar is almsgiving, or charity, through which Muslims help those in need and strengthen the community. The fourth pillar is fasting during the month of Ramadan, a time of self-discipline and empathy for others. The fifth pillar is the pilgrimage to Mecca, which Muslims who are able undertake at least once in their lifetime, symbolizing unity and equality among believers. Altogether, these pillars shape daily worship, moral action, and a sense of belonging to a larger faith community.
