 - Capitalization of My; correct comma usage in series; too → to; verb agreement.
- 4. On Friday, we visited the mosque and cleaned the prayer area.
 - Capitalization of Friday; mosque lowercase in general reference; tense corrected.
- 5. They are making cards to cheer up kids in the hospital for Eid.
 - Verb agreement fixed; capitalization of Eid.
- 6. Fatima and I will plant flowers in Mrs. Noor's garden tomorrow.
 - Capitalization of names; Mrs. punctuation; possessive added; correct pronoun I.

Teacher's Guide

- Review three target skills before starting:
 - Capital letters for names, holidays, and sentence beginnings
 - Commas in a list
 - Correct verb tenses and subject-verb agreement
- Model editing one sentence together as a class.

Differentiation

- Support: Highlight the errors first or provide an editing checklist.
- Challenge: Students create two more "good deed" sentences with intentional errors and swap with a partner for editing.
- ELL Support: Provide visual reminders for capitalization rules and verb tense timelines.
