Teacher's Guide

- **Purpose:** This activity helps students recognize and retain rare or advanced vocabulary words often seen in literature, debates, and academic writing.
- **Teaching Tips:**
 - Read a few words aloud dramatically and have students infer meanings before revealing the choices.
 - Discuss how root words or prefixes (like *ob-* or *voc-*) provide clues to meaning.
- **Differentiation:**
 - *Support:* Offer simplified synonyms or visual aids.
 - *Enrichment:* Challenge advanced learners to write short sentences or micro-stories using all eight words correctly.
- **Engagement Idea:** Turn it into a "Word Duel" game where students "battle" by explaining a word's meaning faster than their partner.
- **Extension Activity:** Encourage students to find one rare word in their next independent reading and share its definition and usage with the class.
