## Seasonal Links Answer Key

1. **Because Dr. Seuss's birthday is March 2.**

*Teacher note:* Connects a calendar event to an author's real birthday.

2. **Clocks move forward one hour, giving longer daylight in the evenings.**

*Teacher note:* Students should explain real-life impact, not just repeat the date.

3. **Pi Day is 3/14, matching the digits of pi (3.14).**

4. **St. Patrick's Day celebrates Irish culture, traditions, and heritage.**

5. **Because March 20 is the spring equinox, marking the start of spring.**

6. **Spring cleaning is a tradition tied to the season, so the clean-up matches the start of warmer weather.**

7. **Easter Sunday is a major holiday, so the school is closed.**

8. **Daylight Saving Time (Mar 9) and First Day of Spring (Mar 20).**

*Teacher note:* Both involve seasonal changes.
