1. Because Dr. Seuss's birthday is March 2.

Teacher note: Connects a calendar event to an author's real birthday.

2. Clocks move forward one hour, giving longer daylight in the evenings.

Teacher note: Students should explain real-life impact, not just repeat the date.

- 3. Pi Day is 3/14, matching the digits of pi (3.14).
- 4. St. Patrick's Day celebrates Irish culture, traditions, and heritage.
- 5. Because March 20 is the spring equinox, marking the start of spring.
- 6. Spring cleaning is a tradition tied to the season, so the clean-up matches the start of warmer weather.
- 7. Easter Sunday is a major holiday, so the school is closed.
- 8. Daylight Saving Time (Mar 9) and First Day of Spring (Mar 20).

Teacher note: Both involve seasonal changes.
