• Email 1 → Scam

Clues: Generic greeting ("Dear Bank Customer"), urgent threat, request for Social Security number and password.

• Email $2 \rightarrow \text{Legit}$

Clues: Specific school event, no request for sensitive data, clear details about time/place.

• Email $3 \rightarrow Scam$

Clues: Too-good-to-be-true prize, request for bank account details and ID, urgent deadline.

Email 4 → Legit

Clues: Professional tone, relevant to workplace, no suspicious requests, realistic attachments.

Teacher Notes / Guide

- This worksheet builds critical digital literacy by training students to recognize email scams.
- Encourage students to identify red flags: urgency, threats, vague greetings, personal data requests, or unrealistic rewards.
- Extension activity: Have students write their own "fake scam" email with red flags, then swap with a partner to spot the clues.
