

Lantern of Warning Answer Key

1. **Clues Suggesting Trouble:** The lantern's flame flickering despite being full, the darkening sky with strong winds, the distant howl, and Nora's nervous glance at the forest.
2. **Suspense:** These details create unease, warning readers that danger or a frightening event is approaching. The atmosphere grows tense with each clue.
3. **Symbolism of Lantern:** The dim lantern may symbolize fading safety, light, or hope. It hints that the characters will face darkness, literal or figurative.
4. **Predictions:** Students might predict that something threatening will come from the forest, the lantern will fail when it's most needed, or that the storm outside reflects an upcoming conflict inside the cabin.

Teacher Notes:

- Encourage students to notice **patterns** (weakening light, darkening sky, strange sounds) as classic foreshadowing signals.
- Remind them that foreshadowing often uses **symbols** (e.g., failing lantern) and **setting details** (storm, shadows) to prepare the reader.
- Stress that predictions don't need to be "correct"; they just need to be supported with evidence from the text.
