## **Attic Mystery Answer Key**

- Exposition: Maya is introduced as a curious child who wonders about her grandmother's attic. The setting is a rainy afternoon in her grandmother's house.
- 2. **Rising Action**: Maya notices the attic door is open, sneaks inside, and finds the glowing lantern. She sees strange visions of the past.
- 3. Climax: The lantern suddenly flares, cracks echo through the attic, and Maya realizes it shows powerful memories.
- 4. **Falling Action**: Maya calms herself, the lantern dims, and the attic returns to normal. She gently puts the lantern back.
- 5. **Resolution**: Maya leaves the attic quietly, choosing not to tell anyone, but she understands she has uncovered a family secret.

## **Teacher Notes:**

- Encourage students to notice how suspense builds through Maya's actions (exposition → rising action).
- The climax should stand out as the most intense, dramatic point (the lantern flaring and revealing its power).
- Reinforce that resolution doesn't always mean "everything explained"—
  sometimes it's a character making a choice or learning something.
