Strategy Tracker Answer Key

Answers will vary. Teachers should check for:

- Clear identification of at least two strategies with specific examples.
- Reasonable explanation of which strategy was most effective and why.
- Honest reflection on confusion and how it was addressed.
- Evidence of metacognitive thinking, such as monitoring, adjusting, and evaluating reading behaviors.

Teacher's Guide

- This worksheet encourages **metacognitive awareness**, helping students recognize and refine their own reading processes.
- For differentiation:
 - Provide sentence starters such as The strategy that helped me most was because.
 - Offer a model response for students new to reflection logs.
- For engagement:
 - Let students compare logs in small groups and discuss differences in strategies.
 - Have students track their strategy use weekly and graph which ones they rely on most often.
- For extension:
 - Connect reflection logs to specific disciplines such as science or history to highlight how strategy use changes across subjects.
 - Encourage students to create personal reading goals based on their metacognitive patterns.
