Tricky Words Students May Identify

- **slippery, southward** (multi-syllabic and "sl" cluster)
- **buzzing, blossoms** (z and bl blend)
- **pranced, painted** (pr / pa quick shifts)
- **swiftly, froth** (fr blend, th ending)
- **lovely, nights** (soft vs. hard consonants)

Teacher Notes

- **Purpose:** This activity strengthens **articulation, pacing, accuracy, and automaticity** by requiring multiple speed attempts.
- Encourage students to **enunciate clearly** when speeding up rather than sacrificing accuracy.
- Pair students for peer feedback; one reads while the other checks ✓ in the chart.
- Use as a **warm-up exercise** for fluency before longer passages.
- Challenge advanced readers to **create their own tongue twisters** using alliteration.
