Teacher's Guide

- **Differentiation:**
 - Review each genre with short examples before students begin.
 - Allow struggling readers to work with a partner.
 - Challenge advanced students to name a second possible purpose and explain why it is weaker.
- **Engagement Tips:**
 - Display real examples of each genre in the classroom.
 - Let students sort classroom books by genre before matching purposes.
 - Turn the activity into a quick team challenge with verbal responses.
- **Extension Ideas:**
 - Have students write one short piece in any genre and label its purpose.
 - Create a genre and purpose anchor chart.
 - Connect this lesson to writing by having students choose a genre and purpose before drafting.
