Teacher's Guide

- **Differentiation:**
 - Read each item aloud for emergent readers.
 - Allow students to point instead of circle if fine motor skills are still developing.
 - Challenge advanced students to explain why they chose a purpose using complete sentences.
- **Engagement Tips:**
 - Act out a few examples and have students guess the purpose before circling.
 - Let students sort the items into three groups after completing the worksheet.
 - Turn it into a movement game where students move to three labeled corners of the room.
- **Extension Ideas:**
 - Have students write one sentence for each purpose.
 - Create a classroom poster with examples of **to learn**, **to enjoy**, and **to follow directions**.
 - Connect the lesson to real classroom materials like signs, storybooks, and instructions.
