Teacher's Guide

- **Differentiation:**
 - Read each text type and purpose aloud for beginning readers.
 - Allow students to color-code matches instead of drawing lines.
 - Ask higher-level students to explain their match using the word **because**.
- **Engagement Tips:**
 - Bring in real examples like a recipe card, poster, or storybook.
 - Let students act out how they would use each text type.
 - Create a classroom anchor chart for **to learn**, **to enjoy**, and **to follow directions**.
- **Extension Ideas:**
 - Have students draw their own example of one text type and label its purpose.
 - Sort classroom books and papers by reading purpose.
 - Challenge students to write one sentence explaining why a recipe is read **to follow directions**.
