Teacher's Guide

- **Objective:** Help students identify safe versus unsafe social situations and practice making responsible choices.
- **Differentiation Tips:**
 - Read scenarios aloud for emerging readers.
 - Use visuals or gesture prompts to support understanding of "safe" and "unsafe."
 - Allow students to explain their reasoning verbally or in writing.
- **Engagement Strategies:**
 - Have students role-play a few of the safe scenarios.
 - Discuss what to do in unsafe situations and who to tell.
- **Extension Ideas:**
 - Create student-made safety posters showing examples of safe choices.
 - Have students write one extra "safe" and one "unsafe" example from their own experiences.
