1. Lincoln

Meaning: He wanted peace and forgiveness after the Civil War. Connection: He believed the country should reunite without revenge against the South.

2. Johnson

Meaning: Southern states must accept the end of slavery and other changes.

Connection: He expected the South to follow new laws in order to rejoin the Union.

3. Douglass

Meaning: Freedom means having equal political rights, including voting. Connection: He fought for African American civil rights during Reconstruction.

Short response: Answers will vary but should include reasoning about lasting change.
