Energy Sources: Debate Prompts

Energy is at the heart of modern life, but how we create it can shape our planet's future. In this activity, you will take a stance on the debate: "Should society rely more on renewable energy than nonrenewable energy?"

Part A - Choose a Side

Decide if you are FOR or AGAINST society relying more on renewable energy.

- FOR Renewable Energy: Argue that solar, wind, hydropower, geothermal, and biomass should become the main sources of energy.
- AGAINST Renewable Energy: Argue that coal, oil, and natural gas should continue to be heavily used for energy needs.

Part B - Debate Prompts

Respond to the following prompts in writing (3-4 sentences each). Be sure to support your answers with facts.

- 1. What is the strongest advantage of your side's energy choice?
- 2. What is one **weakness** of your side's energy choice that your opponent might bring up? How would you respond?
- 3. How does your side's energy choice affect the environment?
- 4. How does your side's energy choice affect the economy (jobs, cost, reliability)?
- 5. Imagine society 50 years from now if your side "wins." What will the world look like?

Reflection: After writing your arguments, switch sides and list **one reason the other side might be right**.
