

## Couplet Creators Answer Key

### Possible Rhyming Sentences:

1. The cat wore a silly hat.
2. The frog sat on a log.
3. We bake pies near the lake.
4. She will sing when she gets her ring.
5. Stars shine bright in the night with light.

### Follow-Up Task (Sample Answer):

- From #2: *The frog sat on a log, / While watching a dog in the fog.*  
(Answers will vary; any sensible rhyming sentences are acceptable.)

### Teacher Notes / Guide

- **Purpose:** This activity combines **creative sentence writing** with **fluency practice**. By generating sentences that end with rhyming words, students reinforce **phonological awareness** while practicing smooth oral reading.
- **Implementation Tips:**
  - Model one example on the board before students begin independently.
  - Encourage students to reread their sentences chorally in pairs or small groups.
  - Ask students to clap or tap to emphasize the rhyme at the end of each sentence.
- **Differentiation:**
  - For beginning writers: allow students to orally suggest sentences and you record them.
  - For advanced writers: challenge them to extend sentences into full four-line rhyming stanzas.
