Rhyme Relay

Directions: Form a small group or work with a partner. One person starts by reading the first word in a chain. The next person reads the next rhyming word, and so on, until the chain is complete. After finishing a chain, reread it together smoothly and quickly. Switch roles so everyone gets a chance to start the chain.

Chain 1 (-at family):

cat → hat → sat → mat → flat

Chain 2 (-op family):

hop → top → mop → stop → drop

Chain 3 (-ake family):

lake → bake → make → rake → shake

Chain 4 (-ing family):

sing → ring → wing → king → bring

Chain 5 (-ell family):

bell → sell → tell → well → shell
