## Sketch A Rhyme Answer Key

Answers will vary. Possible rhymes include:

1. snail - pail
2. kite - night
3. frog - log
4. boat - coat
5. chair - bear
6. cake - lake

### Teacher's Guide

- **Skill focus:** Students connect **ending sounds** to rhymes, then show understanding through drawing and optional writing.
- **Differentiation:**
  - Support: Give two choices orally for each word (boat - coat or boat - bug) and have students pick the rhyming one.
  - Challenge: Ask students to generate **two** rhymes for one picture word and choose one to draw.
- **Engagement:** Let students do a quick "rhyme whisper" with a partner before drawing, then share one rhyme aloud.
- **Extension:** Have students label their drawing with a simple sentence using both rhyme words; example: "The frog sits on a log."
