## Picture Rhymes Answer Key

Correct answer: **coat**

### Teacher's Guide

- **Skill focus:** Students listen for **ending sounds** and identify one correct rhyme in a short, simple task.
- **How to use:** Read the poem aloud once, then have students repeat the last word (boat) before choosing.
- **Differentiation:**
  - Support: Say each option aloud and have students vote which one sounds the same at the end.
  - Challenge: Ask students to think of one more rhyme for boat (goat, coat, float).
- **Engagement:** Let students whisper the rhyme pair to a partner before circling.
- **Extension:** On the back, students draw a quick sketch of the rhyme pair they circled.
