## Rhyme Sentence Answer Key

Answers may vary. Example answers:

1. The **cat** wears a **hat**.
2. A **bee** lands by the **tree**.
3. The **frog** sits on a **log**.
4. I see a **fish** on a **dish**.
5. The **goat** rides in a **boat**.
6. I spot a **star** near a **jar**.

### Teacher's Guide

- **Skill focus:** Students use rhyming words in complete sentences while practicing **spacing, capitals, and punctuation**.
- **How to use:** Preview each rhyming pair orally first, then have students echo the pair before writing.
- **Differentiation:**
  - Support: Provide a word bank for the blanks and write the first sentence together.
  - Challenge: Students add one describing word to each sentence (The fuzzy cat wears a tall hat.).
- **Engagement:** Let students act out one sentence after writing, using simple gestures for each rhyming word.
- **Extension:** Students choose one rhyming pair and write a new sentence with the same two rhyming words.
