Teacher's Guide

- **Skill focus:** Students identify a word that does not rhyme, then replace it with a correct rhyme using the Word Bank.
- **How to use:** Have students underline the matching ending sound in the rhyming pair before choosing a replacement.
- **Differentiation:**
 - Support: Read each set aloud and offer two Word Bank choices for the fix.
 - Challenge: Students write a second possible fix, then explain why it rhymes using ending sounds.
- **Engagement:** After each fix, students do a quick "rhyme check" by saying the new trio aloud together.
- **Extension:** Students create one of their own broken rhyme trios and a mini Word Bank for a partner to repair.
