Teacher's Guide

- **Skill focus:** Students practice hearing **rhyming endings** and spotting the word that sounds different.
- **How to run it:** Read each set aloud once, then have students whisper-read and decide before crossing out.
- **Differentiation:**
 - Support: Offer a sentence frame: "I hear -at in cat and hat, so I cross out sun."
 - Challenge: After crossing out, students say a new rhyme for the pair (cat, hat, bat).
- **Engagement:** Use a quick call-and-response: teacher says the first word, class says a rhyme (star, car).
- **Extension:** Students write one new "odd one out" set of three words for a partner to solve.
