### Teacher's Guide

- **Objective:** Strengthen students' use of positive, respectful sentence starters and social phrases in everyday interactions.
- **Differentiation Tips:**
  - Read the sentences aloud for students who need auditory support.
  - Provide visual cues (gesture cards or emotion faces) for each social phrase.
  - Allow students with writing challenges to point to the correct words instead of writing.
- **Engagement Ideas:**
  - Have pairs practice short role-plays using their completed sentences in real-life examples.
  - Encourage students to use props (toys, pencils, or classroom objects) to act out the situations.
- **Extension Activities:**
  - Ask students to create two new social scripts using the same word bank.
  - Discuss how tone and body language change how these phrases sound to others.
