- 3. **Transportation** → Prefix: *trans* (across) | Root: *port* (carry) | Suffix: -ation (process of) → *The process of carrying across*
- 4. **Prediction** \rightarrow Prefix: *pre* (before) | Root: *dict* (say) | Suffix: *-ion* (act of) \rightarrow *The act of saying before it happens*
- 5. **Disrespectful** → Prefix: *dis* (not) | Root: *spect* (look) | Suffix: *-ful* (full of) → Full of not looking at with respect; rude

- 8. **Biography** \rightarrow Prefix: *bio* (life) | Root: *graph* (write) | Suffix: -y (result of) \rightarrow A written story of someone's life
- 9. **Miscommunication** → Prefix: *mis* (wrong) | Root: *communic* (share) | Suffix: *-ation* (process of) → *The process of sharing wrongly or unclearly*
- 10. Antifreeze \rightarrow Prefix: anti- (against) | Root: freeze (to make cold) | Suffix: none \rightarrow A liquid that works against freezing
