Sample Responses

1. reform, formation - *"The team plans to reform the system."*
2. attract, tractor - *"The magnet can attract small metal pieces."*
3. inspect, spectacle - *"The teacher inspected the project closely."*
4. describe, inscribe - *"She inscribed her name inside the book."*
5. predict, contradict - *"He predicted that it would rain tomorrow."*
6. transport, portable - *"The portable charger is easy to carry."*
7. erupt, disrupt - *"The loud noise disrupted the meeting."*
8. credible, incredible - *"The story was incredible to believe."*
9. transmit, permit - *"The radio transmits sound across distances."*
10. expose, compose - *"He composed a song for the school event."*

Teacher's Guide

- **Focus Skill:** Understanding and manipulating **root words**, **prefixes**, and **suffixes** to expand vocabulary.
- **Differentiation Tips:**
 - For younger or struggling learners: provide a prefix/suffix list for reference (e.g., *re-*, *pre-*, *-tion*, *-able*).
 - For advanced learners: challenge them to identify **Greek and Latin origins** and discuss word families.
- **Engagement Ideas:**
 - Turn this into a "Word-Building Competition" where students earn points for correctly built and creatively used words.
 - Encourage students to illustrate one of their new words for visual reinforcement.
- **Extension Activities:**
 - Have students create a "Word Tree" showing how multiple words grow from one root.
 - Ask them to find 5 real-world examples (in books, signs, or online) of words sharing the same root.
