Teacher's Guide

- **Focus Skill:** Reinforcing understanding of **root words** and how they reveal meaning within complex vocabulary.
- **Differentiation Tips:**

 - For advanced learners: Have students create their own riddles using new roots (e.g., *chrono*, *geo*, *photo*).
