women for using magic.
Governor Phips orders the Court of Oyer and Terminer to be created to
handle the growing number of trials.
Bridget Bishop is the first person tried and executed for witchcraft in Salem.
Spectral evidence (claims of invisible spirits) is allowed in court, leading to
more convictions.
The hysteria spreads, and many people, including respected community
members, are arrested.
Governor Phips steps in and stops the use of spectral evidence because too
many innocent people are being accused.
The court finds several people not guilty, showing that doubt about the trials
is growing.
Governor Phips finally ends the special court, and many remaining prisoners
are released
