Teacher's Guide

- This worksheet builds skills in using **context clues** to determine the meaning of science vocabulary.
- For differentiation, read the passage aloud first and pause after each bold word to model thinking out loud.
- For engagement, have students act out the storm events using sound and movement.
- For extension, challenge students to write one new sentence using each bold word correctly.
- For advanced learners, ask students to identify the type of context clue used such as definition, example, or description.
- For struggling readers, allow them to underline clue words in the same sentence as the vocabulary word before answering.
