Sample Expansions

- My cat, **a lazy Siamese**, slept on the couch.
- The concert, **a once-in-a-lifetime event**, was unforgettable.

Teacher Notes

- **Key Concept:** Appositive phrases add descriptive detail and help expand simple sentences.
- **Comma Rule:** Use commas to set off non-essential appositives; do not use commas if the appositive is essential for identifying the noun.
- **Flexibility:** Answers may vary widely; encourage creativity while ensuring the appositive correctly renames the noun.
- **Extension Idea:** Have students underline the appositive phrase in each sentence to reinforce recognition.
