Relative Builders Answer Key

(Students' answers may vary; any correct use of **who**, **which**, or **that** is acceptable.)

1. The girl, **who** won the spelling bee, is my cousin.
2. I borrowed a book **that** was about space travel.
3. The teacher gave us homework **which** was very challenging.
4. The dog, **which** lives next door, barked loudly.
5. He met a singer **who** performed at the concert.
6. We visited a museum **that** had dinosaur fossils.
7. She wore a necklace **which** was a gift from her grandmother.
8. I know a man **who** can speak six languages.

Sample Expansions

- I saw a student **who** always helps others.
- We bought a car **which** runs on electricity.
- This is the movie **that** won the award.

Teacher Notes

- **Key Concept:** Relative clauses expand sentences by adding more detail about a noun.
- **Flexibility:** Encourage variety; students can often use more than one relative pronoun correctly.
- **Punctuation Reminder:** Use commas for non-essential clauses ("The girl, who won the spelling bee, is my cousin") and no commas for essential clauses ("I borrowed a book that was about space travel").
- **Extension Idea:** Ask students to highlight the relative pronoun in each sentence to reinforce identification.
