Under-Word Prepositions

A **prepositional phrase** begins with a **preposition** and ends with a **noun (object of the preposition)**. In diagrams, the **preposition** is placed on a slanted line under the word it modifies, and the **object of the preposition** is placed on a horizontal line attached to the slant.
