FANBOYS Link Lines

A **compound sentence** has two independent clauses joined by a coordinating conjunction (for, and, nor, but, or, yet, so). In diagramming:

- Each clause is diagrammed on its own main line.
- A **dotted line** with the **conjunction** connects the two verbs.
