Diagram The Relatives

A **relative clause** begins with **who, which, or that** and describes a noun. In diagrams, the relative clause is connected with a **dotted line** from the noun it modifies to the verb in the clause. The relative pronoun (**who, which, that**) sits on the dotted line.
