



## Timed Fluency Focus

**Directions:** You will read a **stack of sentences** for **30 seconds**. Focus on **accurate, clear reading** rather than rushing. If you make an error, quickly correct it and keep going. After 30 seconds, stop where you are and mark the last word you read. Then reread the same stack again, this time trying to reach a little farther **while staying just as accurate**. At the end, record how many sentences you read accurately in 30 seconds.
